
WHAT MAKES A MOSQUITO?

- A long piercing-sucking proboscis, with scales on it!
- Scales on the wings and body
- 3 basic body parts
 - Head
 - Thorax
 - 2 (=one pair) wings
 - 6 (= 3 pairs) legs
 - Abdomen















Thoracic Morphology



M = Media


CuA = Cubitus anterior


Hind Leg Morphology


